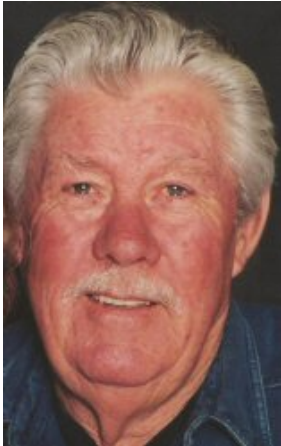

Funeral Services for Roger Richardson of Hay Springs, will be held on Tuesday, May 1, 2012 at 2:00 PM at St. Peter's Lutheran Church, Mirage Flats, south of Hay Springs. Roger was born on October 6, 1933 in Lyman, NE to Jack and Dorothy Richardson. He and his family farmed in Lyman until spring 1947 when they moved to the Mirage Flats area where he acquired his passion for farming and ranching. In 1965, Roger received Outstanding Young Farmer awarded by the U.S. Junior Chamber of Commerce in recognition of exceptional progress in agriculture and contributions to the community.

Roger enjoyed his family and friends immensely and was known for his dynamic sense of humor and storytelling. He enjoyed nature, reading, hunting, and Western and Native American history.
