Ronald "Gary" Buchheit, age 64, died Wednesday, April 25, 2012 at his home in Hemingford.

He was born the first part of twins on January 28, 1948 in Pontiac, Michigan to Robert G. and Janice (Libby) Buchheit. He grew up in Farmington, Michigan playing baseball with his twin brother Larry as young boys. He attended Clarenceville High School where he ran varsity track and cross-country.

After graduation he pursued his machinist's apprenticeship at Godin Tool and Die where he worked side by side with his father for four years. During this time, his love for cars, motorcycles, hunting and fishing became his passion. Gary migrated to Montana in the mid 1970's where he went to work for the Burlington Northern Railroad.
