## (Wyo.)-Day At The State Legislature

CHEYENNE, Wyo. (AP) - Events on the 11th day of 2013 General Session of the Wyoming Legislature: Tues., Jan. 22:

**EDUCATION REFORM:** The House Appropriations Committee voted unanimously to advance a bill that would strip many of the powers from the office of State Superintendent of Public Instruction. The bill, which already has passed the Senate, now heads to the House.

**ARREST RECORDS:** The House defeated a bill that would have changed state law to allow the release of names of people charged with sexual assault before until they're bound over to district court.

**FOOD FREEDOM:** The House gave preliminary approval to a bill that would exempt the sale of some food from state certification and inspection.

**ROAD KILL:** A bill that would set regulations for the possession of road-killed animals received preliminary approval in the House.

**MYTHICAL CREATURE:** A bill that would designate the jackalope as the state's official mythical creature received preliminary approval in the House.
