The Sandhills Journey Scenic Byway will host the 2<sup>nd</sup> annual *Follow the Rails Art Trail* on October 19-21<sup>st</sup>. This is a self-guided art tour in 10 host communities on Nebraska Highway 2 between Grand Island and Alliance.

The Art Trail will feature the work of over 30 Nebraska artists who specialize in paintings, pottery, photography, sculpting and more. The traveler will also have the opportunity to view the world class natural wonders along the Scenic Byway including the abundant wildlife, the Nebraska National Forest and the beautiful Sandhills. The Byway runs parallel to the Burlington Northern Railroad so this tour is a must for train lovers!
