In addition to serving as vice-chair, Bieganski serves as the chair of the academic and personnel committee. Born in El Reno, Okla., Bieganski attended high school in Chadron before earning his degree in business administration and economics at Chadron State College.

Bieganski is president emeritus of the CommunityHospital in McCook where he was responsible for strategic planning, facility development and administrative operations of the hospital. Bieganski was first appointed to the Board in 2006 to fill the unexpired term of Steve Lewis, formerly from Lexington. Bieganski was reappointed to a six-year term by Governor Heineman in 2011.
