**(Neb.)-New Superintendent Hired At Chadron State Park**

(CHADRON)-Gregg Galbraith of Louisville, who has worked for the Nebraska Game and Parks Commission since 1994, has been named the new superintendent of Chadron State Park. He will begin his new duties March 10.

Galbraith has been assistant superintendent at Platte River State Park for 13 years. A native of Crete, Galbraith earned a bachelor's degree in natural resources from the University of Nebraska at Lincoln in December 1993. He got his start with the commission as a groundskeeper at Mahoney State Park near Ashland in 1994. He soon advanced to the position of Mahoney's groundskeeper supervisor, a job he had for seven years before moving to Platte River State Park.

Galbraith will transition to his new duties by alternating weeks between Platte River and Chadron State Park. In mid-May, he will be at Chadron full-time.

Galbraith and his wife Jennifer have a daughter, Kayley, 11, and a son, Caden, 9. The new superintendent succeeds Dave Kinnamon, who was hired late last summer to be superintendent at Lewis and Clark State Recreation Area after six years at Chadron.
