(Wyo.)-New GED Exams Offer Students More Options

CHEYENNE, Wyoming (AP) - Wyoming students seeking a high school equivalency certificate will soon have three testing options instead of just one.

In January, the state will start offering the new GED, the High School Equivalency Test, and the Test Assessing Secondary Completion.

Troy Tallabas is manager of the high school equivalency certificate program with the Wyoming Community College Commission.

Tallabas says that each of the tests brings something different.

He is working on what testing centers will offer which tests, but he says there will be access across the state for all three.

The tests are expected to carry different costs. Currently, the new GED is set to cost about \$120. The other tests are expected to be about \$50.
