BREAKFAST

Notice to Staff of Asbestos Containing Materials

The Asbestos Hazard Emergency Response Act (AHERA), passed in 1986, requires all public and private schools to inventory and inspect all buildings within the system for asbestos containing material (ACM). This initial inspection was conducted in 1988.

The district is required to annually notify employees, building occupants and parents/ guardians about asbestos activities. Please be advised that these Management Plans are on file in the school's administrative office and are open for public inspection during office hours. Complete copies of the Management Plan are available for the cost of reproduction. Every six months the school is required to have the ACM surveyed to determine if the asbestos material has deteriorated or been damaged in any way. The Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) requires the district to perform re-inspections of asbestos materials every three years by an accredited/licensed asbestos inspector, followed by a written report filed with the Office of the Superintendent.

A list of all the school district's asbestos containing materials is located in the Management Plan, and any action to remove or repair the asbestos is also listed in the Management Plan which is open to public inspection. The three-year re-inspection reports are also available for public inspection.
