Tuesdays 5 -6:45 PM; Wednesdays 10 AM - 11:45 AM; limited to 3 times monthly

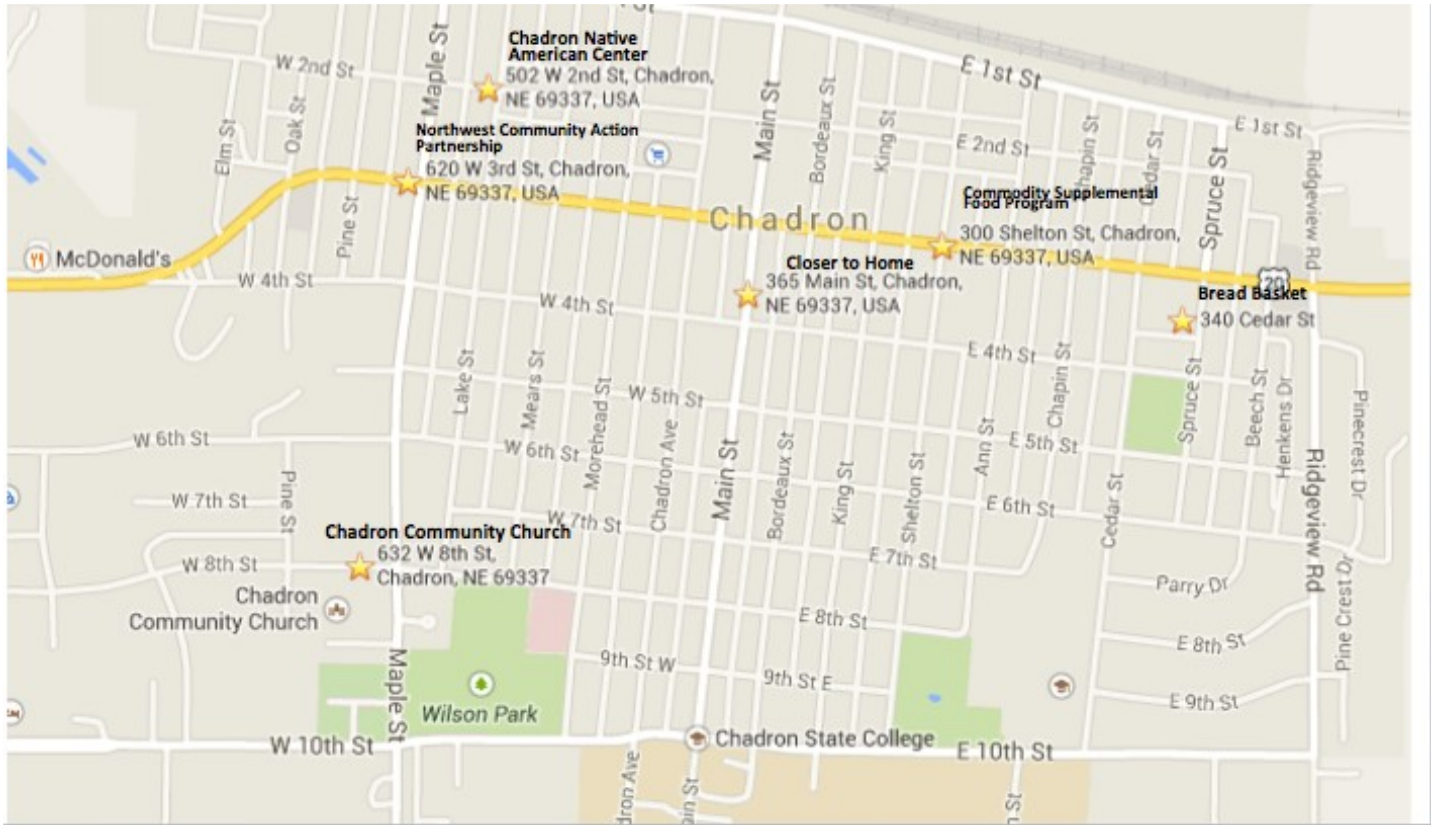
**Northwest Community Action Partnership** - Emergency food, utility rent and other assistance. Monthly food distribution. Other service offered for low-income residents.
